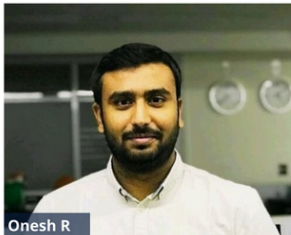

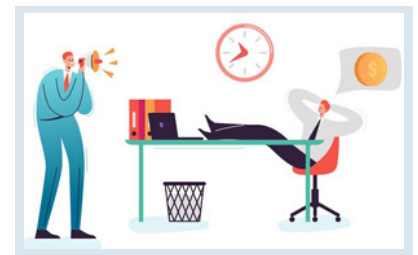

Sorghum Medley Recipe

Recipe Servings: 2 | Total Cook Time: 25 mins | Difficulty Level: Easy

Ingredients

1 Tbsp oil | 2 tbsp mustard seeds | 15-20 curry leaves | Green chilies (deseeded) | 1 tbsp ginger | 2-3 baby corn (diced) | 1/2 cucumber, chopped | 1 red pepper, chopped | 1 yellow pepper, chopped | Pepper and Salt (to taste) | 1 cup Sorghum seeds (Jowar)

How to Make

- Soak the Sorghum seeds overnight and boil them in the same water for 15 minutes.
- Heat the oil in a pan. Add mustard seeds, curry leaves, green chilies and ginger.
- When the seeds splutter, add baby corn; after a minute, add cucumber. Stir fry.
- Add red peppers and yellow peppers. Stir fry.
- Add salt, pepper and cooked Jowar. Toss well. Garnish with coriander and serve.

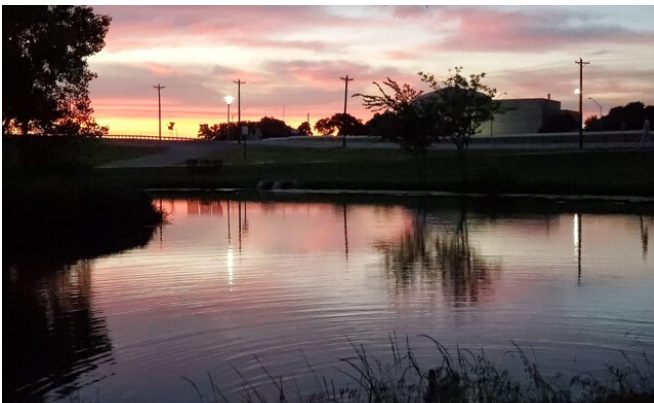
